MESSAGE FROM THE **PRESIDENT**

Dear Members,

The annual general meeting is a time to pause and take stock and to thank all the people who directly or indirectly support the mission and objectives of Inform'Elles. I thank all the members for your continued support over the years that we have persisted in developing a support service for francophone women and girls who are victims of violence in British Columbia. This year of COVID has once again exposed what some call the pandemic of violence against women, many of whom now find themselves confined, forced to live 24 hours a day with their aggressor. That this violence is visible and identified and that governments mobilize to provide additional financial support are signs of positive change.

Let us hope that permanent changes will result.

Our small team of volunteer board members has not changed: Jeanne Landry and Nicole
LeMire never give up and I am very grateful for their commitment, their work and their support. The team of contract workers has been joined by Tessy Vanderhaege, Marlyse Anakeu and Mélinda Trochu. I thank them all on behalf of the Board of Directors for their work under difficult circumstances, with COVID and the great financial uncertainty we have been faced with.

Last year, we were optimistic about entering a promising partnership, but unfortunately, this has been delayed, despite increased funding opportunities in times of COVID. Several grant applications were submitted, and we received funding, but the long delays between applications and remittance of the funds prevented us from moving forward. However, thanks to an extension of our grant from the Department for Women and Gender Equality Canada, we have been able to set up a team that has worked to continue our efforts to strengthen relationships, raise awareness of key sectors of intervention, and seek funding to ensure long-term direct service delivery. We thank the DWGEC.

As of March 2021, after a year of major changes in the way we work, we remain confident that our efforts will bear fruit and that we will once again have a direct service for francophone women and their children who live with violence.
